Founded in 1925, The Junior League of Houston, Inc. is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.



It has been my privilege to serve as the 92nd President of The Junior League of Houston, Inc. This opportunity has afforded me a unique perspective of the far reaching impact of the League. This year's theme was "Heart of a Champion," and I am a believer that our members, patrons and partners are champions in the Houston community. Our members champion by improving the community through various programs and placements while focusing on critical needs. Our patrons and partners champion both financially as well as acting as cheerleaders by sharing the message. Over my past eleven years in the League, I have witnessed the dedication and generosity in our community and count myself fortunate to be a part of Houston and the Junior League.

This year the League contributed over 75,000 hours of volunteer service - the equivalent of eight years through the support of 38 community projects. Beyond trained volunteers, the League invested over \$900,000 in grants and project support to a number of worthy organizations throughout the heart of our community.

The League also has financial supporters. This year the League had 11 Community Partners, who each donated \$20,000 or more during the year. Additionally, underwriters of the 68th Annual Charity Ball, The Bon





Temps Ball, helped raise over \$900,000 in support of League efforts. The League is truly grateful to all who helped in "Building A Better Community" throughout the year.

The League has also had continued success in the third year of the relaunched annual fund. Donations to the League Legends Annual Fund support the community efforts, building preservation and operating expenses of the League. This year's effort exceeded all goals, raising over \$160,000.

At the heart of the League, a few extraordinary events warrant mentioning (there are too many to include all). This year the League executed a Long Range Plan with the input of the active membership. This triannual event assures the League is meeting not only the community's needs but also capturing the member's needs and interests. The League celebrated the 30th birthday of her home at 1811 Briar Oaks Ln. Also, notably the League was the recipient of the Association of Junior Leagues International Fund Development Award. This prestigious award was in recognition of the League's 16 year old Community Endowment Fund, valued at over \$12.8 million. Distributions from the fund enable the League to not only maintain but increase the support back to the community.



Volunteer support is calculated based on the number of volunteer hours committed to a particular community project. Each hour is valued at a market rate of \$23.56, suggested by the Independent Sector and the Points of Light Foundation as of April 2016.

Direct financial support is the actual cash spent for the community endeavors during the fiscal year ending May 31, 2016.

For more than 90 years, The Junior League of Houston, Inc. has been committed to improving the Houston community. The Junior League is committed to exploring new opportunities that expand its community outreach through Community Assistance Grants. The Community Assistance Committee evaluates grant applications for projects in the Houston community that do not currently receive volunteer support from the League and makes funding recommendations to the League's Board of Directors for consideration. Specifically, requests that address a critical or basic need, fund a pilot program and/or expand a significant service to the community are considered.

## FOR 2015 - 2016, THE LEAGUE AWARDED \$150,000 TO STANKE GRANTS TO THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES:

THE CENTER offers high-quality residential, vocational and day services to support its clients and the greater Houston community. League funds will support the Young at Heart Program by expanding services for senior adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities to help them remain physically and socially active, mentally engaged and connected to their community.

CHILDBUILDERS provides a prevention program designed to stop child maltreatment from happening in the first place. The programs provide children the knowledge and skills they need to identify and avert victimization and support social-emotional development. League funds will be used to train and provide program curricula to 46 school personnel to teach the Personal Safety and Relationship Education program to 400 Greater Houston Area children. The funding will include program curricula, a laptop computer, wireless Internet access and resource books.

#### ESCAPE FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER is

a parenting education agency providing child abuse prevention programs and parenting classes to families looking to create a safe, healthy and happy home lives. League funds will significantly expand the ESCAPE Family Resource Center's "Learn to Parent" education efforts to the community through a pilot program offering 11 new and flexible workshops to working parents. The funds will also continue to support The First Five, a program focused on preventing abuse of children under the age of five, the most vulnerable and often abused childhood demographic.

HIS GRACE FOUNDATION provides physical, emotional and financial support to patients and families in the Bone Marrow Transplant Unit at Texas Children's Hospital. League funds will fully furnish a third apartment for their housing program, His Grace Place, to provide temporary and critical post-transplant housing for these families during their loved one's treatment.

THE HOPE AND HEALING CENTER provides education, training and programs that support and strengthen the emotional, mental, physical and spiritual health of families and individuals across the full cycle of life, from birth to elderhood. League funds will support The Hope and Healing Center's new Violence Against Women initiative, designed to offer specialized mental health care services for female survivors of trauma.

HOUSTON A + CHALLENGE'S mission is to be a catalyst for change and a model for innovation in public school education in the Houston area and beyond to ensure that every student is prepared for post-secondary success. League contributions will fund a portion of the A+ Unlimited Potential program for low-income and at-risk middle school students.

INTERFAITH CARE PARTNERS provides caring communities for individuals in need due to age and health-related maladies. Care is provided in-home and onsite at local congregations. League funds will support the continued growth and development of the Care Team program by allowing staff members to provide expertise, training and support to 2,400 congregation-based volunteers.

NORTHWEST ASSISTANCE MINISTRIES has an integrated service model to deliver its mission of meeting basic human needs through "neighbors helping neighbors." League funds will support two programs, including emergency shelter and/or supplies for a new home for approximately 25 women fleeing domestic violence and a daily supplemental meal for 40 homebound seniors for a six-month period.

THE PERIWINKLE FOUNDATION develops and provides programs that positively change the lives of children, young adults and families who are challenged by cancer and other life-threatening illnesses and who are cared for at Texas Children's Hospital. League funds will support Camp Periwinkle in the City, a pilot program to provide a three-day camp for 50 children with cancer and blood disorders who are undergoing treatment at Texas Children's Cancer and Hematology Centers and their siblings.

#### TEXAS CENTER FOR THE MISSING is

dedicated to bringing hope and healing to the missing and their families through crisis intervention, prevention and community education. League funds will develop and implement the new Houston Regional Silver Alert System website, a life-saving emergency alert system for elderly adults often battling dementia. Additionally, funds will provide search and rescue training, specifically for the elderly, to law enforcement officers serving the 14-county Houston-Galveston region.





The Junior League of Houston, Inc.'s Community Partner program develops customized partnerships with corporations, foundations and individuals giving at a level of \$20,000 and above each year. These organizations and individuals are an integral part of the League's mission. For 2015 – 2016, the 11 Community Partners represented the largest number in League history.

#### A Memorable Event

A Memorable Event, one of the League's newest Community Partners, is a premier event planning company in the Houston area A Memorable Event has more than 15 years of event coordination, design and décor implementation in wedding, corporate events and private parties. A Memorable Event supports many of the League's special events throughout the year.

#### The Woman's Hospital of Texas


