EVENT PLANNING GUIDE

In 1925, the Junior League of Houston was founded, and its members launched a clinic for disadvantaged children as their first community project. The clinic created the foundation for the League's relationships with major medical resources in Houston, including Baylor College of Medicine, Ben Taub Hospital, Memorial Hermann – Texas Medical Center, Texas Children's Hospital and The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center. To fund the clinic, members formed a Luncheon Club – the genesis of today's Tea Room, which has been in the League's current building on Briar Oaks Lane since April 1986.

The Tea Room is the League's longest-standing fundraiser and supports the League's exempt purposes by serving as a training facility where members are educated in the discipline of service, which is then carried into various community service projects which the League undertakes. The training and education afforded by the Tea Room enables members to be more effective and efficient community volunteers. The Tea Room is a one-of-a-kind among Junior Leagues around the world, both in size and in the utilization of volunteers in day-to-day operations.

The Tea Room is a Houston tradition and local favorite for delicious meals and to-go staples from the Pantry, as well as a beautiful setting for meetings and social celebrations. The stunning Ballroom serves as host to everything from community events to non-profit fundraisers to wedding receptions. 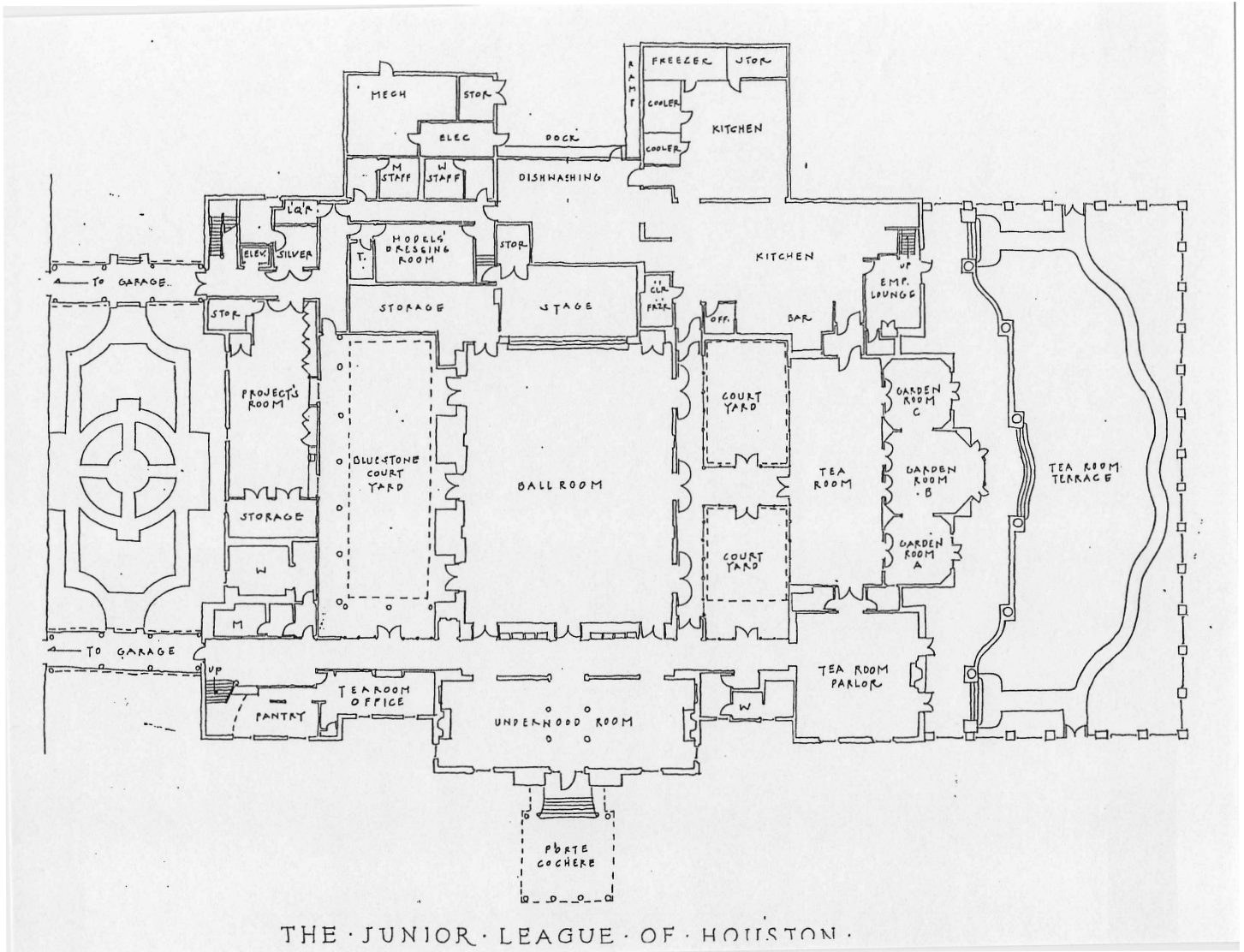

FEES AND CHARGES

MINIMUM FOOD AND/OR ROOM RENTAL CHARGE

ENTIRE BUILDING

Breakfast: \$2,750 Tuesday – Friday

Daytime: \$7,500 Monday – Friday; \$9,000 Saturday; \$7,500 Sunday

Evening: \$7,500 Monday – Thursday; \$9,000 Friday; \$14,000 Saturday; \$7,750 Sunday

BALLROOM

(accommodates up to 350 guests for a seated event or 400 for a cocktail buffet)

Breakfast: \$1,750 Tuesday – Friday

Daytime: \$3,500 Monday – Friday; \$5,000 Saturday; \$5,250 Sunday

Evening: \$5,250 Monday – Friday; \$10,000 Saturday; \$5,250 Sunday

TEA ROOM

(accommodates up to 100 guests for a seated event or 225 for a cocktail buffet)

Breakfast: \$1,000 Tuesday – Friday

Daytime – Evening: \$2,250 Monday – Friday; \$4,000 Saturday; \$2,750 Sunday

ROOM RENTAL WITHOUT FOOD OR ALCOHOL SERVICE

The Ballroom or Tea Room may be rented without food or alcohol service for four hours, plus fees for room attendant and security. Coffee or soft drinks are available at a nominal charge.

Ballroom: \$1,750 Monday – Thursday, \$2,000 Sunday

Tea Room: \$1,000 Monday – Thursday

Breakfast food minimum time is from 6:30 – 9:30 a.m.; daytime food minimum time ends by 2 p.m.; and Saturday afternoon food minimum time is from 2 – 5 p.m.

The above food charge schedule does not include alcoholic beverages or service charge.

All charges are subject to applicable state sales tax and state mixed beverage tax at 8.25 percent.

These guidelines and prices are subject to change without notice. The actual prices for your function will be guaranteed no later than 60 days prior to the event at the time the final arrangements are made with the Tea Room General Manager.

RESERVATION DEPOSITS

Entire Building: \$3,500 **Ballroom:** \$2,500 **Tea Room:** \$1,000

A second deposit is due 30 days prior to the event. The initial deposit and the second deposit are to equal the food minimum.

For nonprofits organizations, a \$500 deposit will apply for daytime and weekday functions only.

Notification to the Tea Room General Manager of the guaranteed number of persons attending the event is required no later than three business days prior to the event.

Cancellation policy: The deposit will be refunded by the League to the Tea Room patron member if written notice of cancellation is received by the League at least 240 days prior to the date of the event. Cancellation of a contract must be made in writing to the Tea Room General Manager and must be acknowledged. Otherwise, the Tea Room patron member remains responsible for the contract, and the deposit will not be refunded.

LABOR CHARGES

Security: Minimum \$175 per officer for three hours, \$50 per hour for each hour after that.

Security officers work 30 minutes before the scheduled event time to 30 minutes after the last guest leaves. One officer must be hired for every 100 minors or every 300 adults.

Service Charge: 20 percent of all food and alcoholic beverages charges will be added for service.

Carver: \$175

Wedding Cake Service: \$1.50 per person

Cashier: \$150

Coat Check: \$150 per attendant

Runway: \$300

Piano: Spinet \$250

Grand \$500

Dance Floor (Tea Room): \$500

Valet Parking: \$40 per hour (three-hour minimum).

Events with primarily couples in attendance require one valet per every 40 guests.

Events with primarily singles in attendance require one valet per every 20 guests.

LCD Projector: \$325

Screen/Portable Screen: \$50

Podium with Microphone: \$75

Lavalier Microphone: \$75

Cordless Microphone: \$75

Event Overtime: Tea room \$500 per hour

Ballroom \$750 per hour

Entire Building \$1,000 per hour

Ceremony Charge: \$1,000*
