underwear. League volunteers will kick off the Back to School program in January 2019 by assembling packages to serve disadvantaged elementary and middle school students.

COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT

The Junior League of Houston is "Building A Better Community" by committing volunteers and financial support to community projects in the Greater Houston Area. The Junior League is thankful for its continued long-standing relationships and proud to celebrate anniversaries with the following agencies:

The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston: 75 years – Volunteers introduce children, families and visitors to art through hands-on activities and events, such as Bayou Bend Family Days.

Casa de Esperanza de los Niños: 35 years – Volunteers help children who have been abused, neglected or affected by HIV. Depending on needs, volunteers read to children, play games, assist with tutoring of special needs children, soothe and feed infants, and work on arts and crafts projects.

Children's Museum of Houston: 30 years – While spending the night at the museum, Overnight Adventures volunteers act as role models for young girls by participating in craft projects, exploring museum exhibits, and cultivating an interest in nutrition and health. Family Learning Night volunteers help children during the museum's free admission nights.
